

Dr.Shailesh Kasande, CEO and Group Director, Survadatta Group of Institutes was the keynote speaker who is a legend in the academic world and a key player in Outcome-Based Education (OBE) which is a student-centric teaching and learning methodology in which the course delivery, assessment are planned to achieve stated objectives and outcomes. He focused on measuring student performance i.e. outcomes at different levels which sir will be touching upon today apart from various other CO-PO mapping which forms a part of the academic accreditation. All attainment analysis is made to provide continuous improvement through either in course delivery, assessment and curriculum. ## **RESEARCH INTEGRITY AND PUBLICATION ETHICS**




# GUIDELINES FOR IMPROVING TEACHERS LECTURE DELIVERY AS PER NAAC
